

Track to Compete at Arizona State, Utah Spring Classics

PROVO, Utah (April 8, 2010) – Craig Poole and Mark Robison will lead the women’s and men’s track and field teams to Tempe, Arizona this weekend for the Sun Angel Classic at Arizona State, and will send several more athletes to the Utah Spring Classic in Salt Lake City.

The hammer throw will be the only collegiate event contested on Friday, and the remainder of the events will take place on Saturday. The women’s discus will get the meet started at 10:00 a.m. MST, and the meet will conclude with the premiere section of the men’s 4x400m relay at 10:30 p.m. MST.

The No. 12 women’s team will be among five USTFCCA ranked teams competing in the meet. Other ranked teams include No. 6 Penn State, No. 9 Oklahoma, No. 14 Auburn and No. 17 Arizona.

On the men’s side, the 20th-ranked Cougars will face off against five other USTFCCA ranked teams. Ranked men’s teams attending include No. 7 Auburn, No. 10 Arizona State, No. 13 Oklahoma, No. 21 Minnesota and No. 22 Kansas State.
